Festival Grants

This scheme offers not-for-profit groups (but not town and parish councils) up to £1,000 towards the cost of community festivals or events taking place in the district. The scheme is open until 1 March 2018, unless we spend all the budget before then.

The events should have lots of community support, be open to anyone and allow a minimum of 100 people to attend. We especially like to help new events establish themselves.
